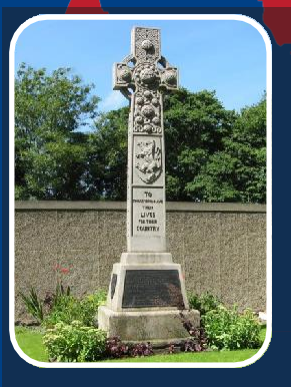

On 22nd May 1915 there was a huge rail disaster at Quintinshill, near Gretna, involving a troop train, a local train and the Glasgow Express. Only half the soldiers on the troop train survived. 216 soldiers from the 1/7th (Leith) Battalion, The Royal Scots, were killed while on route to Liverpool from Larbert, Stirlingshire, heading for Gallipoli.
